

STATEMENT: Kelly Brough SCOTUS Ruling on Abortion Pill

Denver, CO – Today, the U.S. Supreme Court [ruled](#) to block lower courts from banning the abortion pill mifepristone, however use of the pill is still restricted in some states. Mayoral candidate Kelly Brough reacted with the following statement:

“As a woman and mother of two daughters, I’m relieved by today’s decision,” said Kelly Brough. **“However, I’m still outraged by the ongoing attack on reproductive health care rights. If elected mayor, I am committed to stand and protect access to abortion, including medication abortion, and will do everything I can to ensure that those rights are not infringed on.”**
