Kelly Brough Pledges to Listen to Denver Voters and Buy Park Hill Golf Course if Elected Mayor

SOS Denver says "Denver needs a leader who listens to the people, and we trust Kelly Brough to be that leader,"

Denver, CO – Mayoral candidate Kelly Brough, pledges as Denver's next Mayor she will honor the will of the voters and work to buy back the Park Hill Golf Course for the people of Denver.

"Denver voters have spoken. As a city we have voted on this issue three times, and three times the Denver voters have been very clear where they stand on the future of this golf course," **Brough said**. "I supported and voted Yes on 20 because I believe Denver needs more affordable housing – and as mayor I would continue to find ways to build the affordable housing Denver desperately needs. I said from the beginning I would honor the voters and I have heard you loud and clear. As mayor, I will initiate the process for the City of Denver to purchase the land and commit to a transparent and open community process to create a regional park."

"Months ago, Kelly Brough reached out to our group to meet and discuss our position on ballot issue 20. Of the two candidates in the mayoral runoff, Kelly was the only one to take the time to meet with our group of volunteers and to listen to our side of the issue.

While we didn't agree with her decision to vote Yes on 20, she was always clear she would honor the voters' wishes.
